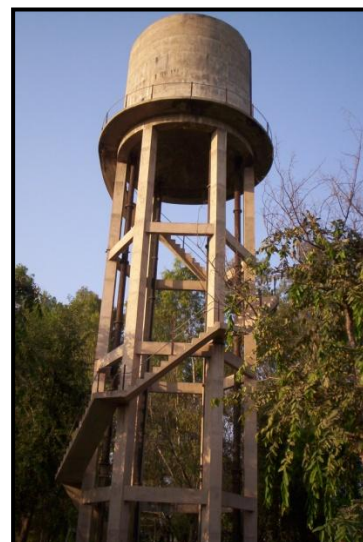

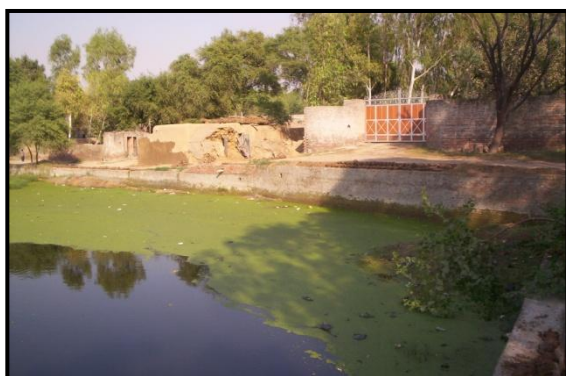

A deep tube well was constructed under the project for supplying potable water to the village. The project worked well for about two years before the motor was stolen. The transformer was also removed by the Gram Panchayat under the threats of theft. Presently, the project is not functioning. Since no user fee was being collected and the Panchayat has no other fund, the project could not be repaired.
