Impact:: The hall was constructed at the Govt. Elementary School, *Odian* village. Construction of the hall was completed a year ago however it is not handed over to the school administration for its proper use. The Hall is rather used as a store for cement, iron sheets, logs and poles and other construction material being used for construction of another building for the school which was upgraded to a high school. The labourers engaged for construction work do cook their food inside the hall. Such uses have left the floor of the hall broken. There is no veranda and the outside ground level is higher than the floor level of the hall which creates a scope for entering rain water into the hall.

The library room though constructed about a year ago is yet to be handed over to the school for its proper uses. Rather it was observed that the hall is being used as a store house of construction material and cooking food for the labour engaged in construction of another building for the high school.

Impact : The Primary Health Centre at *Karni Khera* village caters to the primary health care of about 5000 people of three nearby villages in the border area. The extension facilitated accommodating the out patients for consultation with the doctor. The compound wall protected the hospital compound from trespassing stray animals/dogs and the approach road helped keep the hospital premises clean.

Pattipur, <i>Chowarin Wali</i> , <i>Basti Teja Singh</i> , etc. The road benefits a population of about five thousand people, farmers, small traders, etc. Agriculture being the main occupation of the area, the road facilitates the farmers in the locality to drive tractors and combined harvesters to the farms and also to transport the farm produce like paddy, wheat and vegetables to the market centres.

The lanes were open clay lanes and during rainy days the streets were becoming muddy, slippery and difficult for commuting. The pot holes were holding water and aiding breeding of mosquitoes. Cement concrete flooring of street lanes facilitated the streets and the villages to keep clean. The cost of cc flooring of street lanes exceeded the BADP grant and thus the gram Panchayat has utilized Panchayat fund of about 2.50 lakh to provide cc flooring of street lanes at required place of the village.

The tube well reduced stress and water scarcity especially during the summer season as well as when one or other pump house go out of order.</p> <p>The bore well makes a discharge of about 1550 lpm water and runs about 8-10 hours a day.</p>

However, later on two of the hand pumps were fitted with submersible pump sets by voluntary donation of some individuals in the village and made power driven. The pump sets are working and people do take water from the pumpsets for domestic consumption and consumption of animals. No doubt, it gives easy water but it does not work when there is no power supply.

The Gram Panchayat does bear the maintenance of the tube wells. By the time of the field visit, two of the hand pumps were out of order for a couple of months, as told by the Sarpanch, they were waiting for a mechanic to attend to the repair work.

The deep tube well was meant for supplying drinking water to *Rana Panj Grian* village on the international border line and also to a BSF post near the village. The pump house became functional during June 2009 and was supplying drinking water as desired. The Gram Panchayat was looking after the maintenance of the project. However, for past a few months it is lying nonfunctional as the power was disconnected for nonpayment of electricity bill. As told by the Sarpanch, Sh. Gurdip Singh, the electricity bill came only after one year of functioning the pump and the bill amount was around forty thousand rupees and the Panchayat was not having any source for paying the bill. Subsequently, the transformer also gone out of order. The villagers are collecting water from some tube wells in the neighbourhood while the BSF post had installed a tube well for their own use.

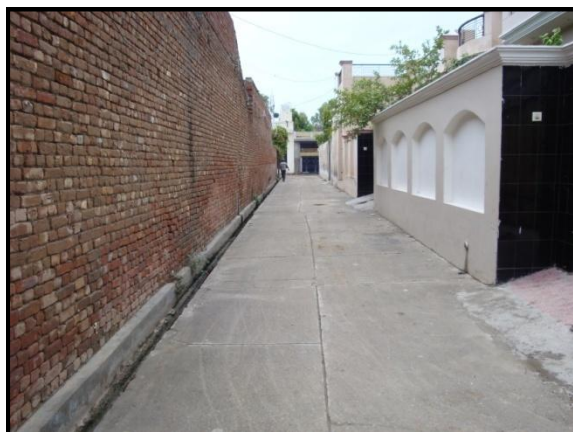
